## How to get your Refrigerator or Freezer Retirement Incentive

1. The customer must be a Member of Missoula Electric Cooperative
2. The appliance must be a minimum of 10 cu. ft. capacity.
3. A copy of disposal/recycling documentation.
4. Removal of Freon statement signed by Contractor/retailer
5. Complete this form and sign at the bottom to have the incentive credited to your account.

Missoula Electric Cooperative will credit your account **\$125.00** for consumers in MEC service area recycles a refrigerator and/or a freezer that is being replaced. This incentive is also available for the removal of currently operating refrigerators or freezers located in garages or other storage areas. This incentive program is a limited offer and is subject to change.

# Refrigerator/Freezer Recycling Information

This information is being provided to assist in meeting the requirements of MEC's Appliance Retirement/Recycling Program. A used appliance may be picked up by a local retailer or a contractor for a local retailer, or you may take it to a recycling site yourself. Either way, a signed statement verifying the appliance will be decommissioned/recycled must accompany the incentive form. This list is not all inclusive. There may be additional local sites or dealers that recycle used appliances.

**R & R Appliances** – Appliance must be taken to their location. They will recycle the Freon (they are a licensed refrigerant capture facility) and scrap the old refrigerator or freezer. The cost is \$40 and they will provide documentation.

**Vann's Appliances** – Members that purchase an Energy Star refrigerator or freezer and have Vann's take their old appliance will pay an additional \$65. Vann's has the Freon recycled and then scraps the refrigerator/freezer. "Freon removal" is written on the invoice to the customer if Vann's is picking up the old appliance. (This will qualify for recycling documentation as long as the invoice states appliance was picked up and/or removed.)

**Lowe's** – When a refrigerator or freezer is purchased from Lowe's, the customer may select to have the old appliance picked up for a \$79 charge. All used refrigerators and freezers are returned to a central location for recycling. (Receipt must document appliance pick up/removal.)

**Home Depot** – Home Depot pays a contractor to pick up the appliance, capture the Freon and scrap the old appliance. **Statement (bottom front) must be filled out.**

**Best Buy** – Members purchasing a refrigerator or freezer from Best Buy may request delivery. The delivery cost includes the pick up of the old appliance. All used refrigerators and freezers are shipped to the warehouse and the Freon is removed and metal is scrapped. (Receipt must state appliance was picked up/removed.)

The receipt from the retailer should state that the old refrigerator/freezer was **picked up and removed**. (However for some retailers this may not be true.) A copy of the receipt, along with the statement (bottom front) needs to be signed by the contractor that picks up the appliance.
